Your letter dated December 6, 2024, submitting a Decrease Bond Rider, to be attached to and form a part of Outer Continental Shelf (OCS) Mineral Lessee's or Operator's Supplemental Bond No. SBP150014\_005, in the amount of \$4,900,000, was received by our office on December 9, 2024. This bond, conditioned to cover Lease OCS-G 15161, all of Block 381, East Cameron Area, South Addition, was executed on December 27, 2022, with Talos ERT LLC as principal and Pennsylvania Insurance Company as surety.

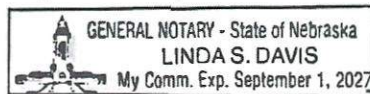
