Your letter dated February 24, 2025, submitting Decrease Bond Rider, Rider No. 1, to be attached to and form a part of Outer Continental Shelf (OCS) Mineral Lessee's or Operator's Supplemental Bond No. GM216857, in the amount of \$750,000, was received by our office on that same date. 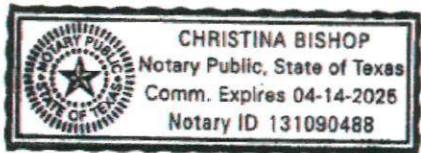
