Dear Mr. Smith:

By letter dated September 6, 2024, LLOG Exploration Offshore, L.L.C. (LLOG) requests approval of a Suspension of Operations (SOO) for the Alaminos Canyon (AC) Block 380 Unit, Agreement No. 754319001. The unit consists of Leases OCS-G 32954, 32964, 36102, 36103, and 36104.

Drilling operations were expected to commence on or before September 20, 2024, on Lease OCS-G 36103, Well No. 1. The contracted rig has been delayed at its previous drilling location due to drilling/operational delays. Unit drilling operations are now expected to commence prior to the end of October 2024, after current operations are completed at the current location and rig mobilization to AC Block 380 Unit.

In accordance with Articles IX, XVI, and XVII of the Unit Agreement and 30 CFR 250.175(a), an SOO for the AC Block 380 Unit is hereby approved from September 21 through October 31, 2024. This unit suspension excludes Leases OCS-G 36102, 36103, and 36104, since the primary terms extend beyond the expiration of this SOO. LLOG must notify this office in writing upon the commencement of unit drilling operations on Lease OCS-G 36103, Well No. 1.
